Proposed Title for Keynote Address: *“Becoming an Evidence-based Practitioner”*

Abstract: Evidence-based practice (EPB) is the current buzzword in social work. It has received attention both in practice and also the academic field. This paper will describe the processes of EBP, what is meant by EBP, what is meant by empirically supported practice, the steps involved in EBP, and questions that can be addressed in EBP. It will articulate the current realities of teaching EBP in social work curricula at the BSW and MSW levels, including both innovations in the classroom and field.
